THE SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

"Holy Father, protect them in your name . . . so that they may be one" (John 17:11). Victor the Moor, martyr, died 303

Also known as Victor Maurus, this native of the northwest African nation of Mauritius was a soldier in the Roman Praetorian Guard. Under the persecution of Maximian, Victor died for his faith at Milan.

Saturday, May 14

Pachomius, renewer of the church, died 346

Born in Egypt, Pachomius became a Christian while a soldier. He became a hermit (a solitary monk) and organized others into a religious community. His rule for monasteries influenced later ones in both the Eastern and Western churches.
