Basil the Great, Bishop of Caesarea, died 379; Gregory of Nazianzus, Bishop of Constantinople, died around 389; Gregory, Bishop of Nyssa, died around 385

The Cappadocian fathers, as these three men are known, explored the mystery of the Holy Trinity. Basil's monastic rule forms the basis for Eastern monastic life.

Gregory of Nazianzus defended orthodox Christianity in Constantinople. Gregory of Nyssa, Basil's younger brother, wrote on the spiritual life.


